

Spectra Inc. Reports First Quarter 2009 Results

Toronto, Ontario – Spectra Inc. (SSA: TSX VENTURE) reports the release of its financial results for the first 3 months of 2009. Revenues for the period ending March 31, 2009 were \$188,647 compared to \$260,689 for the same period in 2008, a decrease of 28 percent.

The first quarter showed a net loss \$70,058 compared to a loss for the three-month period in 2008 of \$180,507.

Spectra Inc., through its wholly owned subsidiary, Spectra Products Inc., is the Toronto-based North American designer, manufacturer and distributor of Brake Safe[®], the visual brake stroke indicating system, Brake Inspector[®], the company's electronic in-cab air brake diagnostic system and the Termin-8R[®] line of anti-corrosion and extreme pressure lubricants. Spectra distributes Zafety Lug Lock[™], an innovative, new product that uses the resistance between wheel nuts to minimize their ability to rotate and loosen, reducing the risk of wheel damage or wheel loss.
