Toronto, Ontario – Spectra Inc. Monthly sales exceeded \$100,000 for the first time in recent corporate history. These improved sales were expected as reported in our press release of September 25th

With the completion of the first production run of the company's digital version of Brake Inspector, we were able to start filling back orders for the product. It is fully expected that sales will also be strong in November as we continue to fill orders

Final results for the third quarter ended September 30, 2007 were released last week. They show that, while the company lost over \$400,000 from operations in the second quarter, the positive impact of the recent management changes and the new sales programs have reduced the operating losses in the third quarter to just over \$100,000.

Spectra Inc., through its wholly owned subsidiary, Spectra Products Inc., is the Toronto-based North American designer, manufacturer and distributor of Brake Safe[®], the visual brake stroke indicating system and Brake Inspector[®], the company's electronic in-cab air brake diagnostic system and the Termin-8R[®] line of anti-corrosion and extreme pressure lubricants. These products are gaining increasing recognition and acceptance as demands for enhanced brake safety increase among regulatory authorities and the motoring public.
